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ARTS, PARKS, HEALTH, AGING AND RIVER COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to the Assignment of the Right to Apply for Proposition A Cities Excess Funds for the Coronado Street Community Park and Garden Acquisition Project.

Recommendation for Council action:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION, attached to the Council file, which assigns to the Los Angeles Neighborhood Land Trust (LANLT) a right to apply for Proposition A Cities Excess Funds in the amount of \$275,000, which are available from the Los Angeles County Regional Park and Open Space District for the First Supervisorial District of the County of Los Angeles, on condition that the funds are used for the completion of the Coronado Street Community Park and Garden Acquisition Project, located within the City of Los Angeles.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) reports that there is no impact to the General Fund as funding for the completion of the project will be the responsibility of LANLT.


Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
ASSIGNING THE RIGHT TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE
LOS ANGELES COUNTY REGIONAL PARK AND OPEN SPACE DISTRICT FOR
THE FIRST SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT CITIES EXCESS FUNDS TO THE
LOS ANGELES NEIGHBORHOOD LAND TRUST FOR THE CORONADO STREET
COMMUNITY PARK AND GARDEN ACQUISITION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the people of the County of Los Angeles on November 3, 1992, and on November 5, 1996, enacted the Los Angeles County Proposition A, Safe Neighborhood Parks Propositions (collectively the Propositions), which among other uses, provide funds to public agencies and nonprofit organizations in the County to be used for the acquisition, development and/or rehabilitation of facilities and open space for public recreation;

WHEREAS, the Propositions also created the Los Angeles County Regional Park and Open Space District (the District) to administer said funds;

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Neighborhood Land Trust (LANLT), a non-profit organization, is requesting that the City of Los Angeles assign the right to apply for Proposition A Cities Excess Funds in the amount of \$275,000, in the First Supervisorial District, to LANLT for use in completing the Coronado Street Community Park and Garden Acquisition Project; and

WHEREAS, the project consists of the acquisition of the property at 739 South Coronado Street, located within the City of Los Angeles, to be used for a future park and garden, which will allow for the creation of safe and accessible recreational opportunities in the City of Los Angeles and benefit other County residents in the First Supervisorial District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES HEREBY:

1. Assigns to the Los Angeles Neighborhood Land Trust (LANLT), a non-profit organization, the right to apply for Proposition A Cities Excess Funds in the amount of \$275,000 in the First Supervisorial District for use in completing the Coronado Street Community Park and Garden Acquisition Project.
