

COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE relative to the selection of Black and White Garage, Inc., to serve as the Official Police Garage (OPG) for Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Service Area 16.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the President, Board of Police Commissioners, or designee, to negotiate and execute an OPG Towing and Storage agreement with Black and White Garage, Inc., for Service Area 16 which is comprised of the Foothill and Mission Areas, and portions of the Devonshire and Van Nuys Areas, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated April 27, 2015, the Board's Executive Director recommends the approval of the selection of Black and White Garage, Inc., to serve as the OPG for LAPD Service Area 16. On July 2, 2014, a Request for Proposals was released for which three responses were received. Proposals were rated on formal business plan, experience, history of contract compliance, customer service, and honesty and integrity. One respondent was deemed non-responsive and disqualified. Black and White Garage received an average score of 90.3, beating the other respondent's score of 64.7. The Board's Executive Director goes on to state that Black and White Garage has served as an OPG for sixty-nine years and does not have any sustained complaints. On May 5, 2015, the Board approved the Executive Director's recommendation.

At the Public Safety Committee meeting held June 12, 2015, the Committee Chair recommended that Council authorize the Board to execute a contract with Black and White Garage to serve as the OPG for LAPD Service Area 16.
