EDUCATION AND NEIGHBORHOODS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to amending Section 22.80 (j) of the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) with regards to creating and maintaining an internal and external information and communication network for Neighborhood Council and public use.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. CONCUR with the actions taken by the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners (BONC) at a meeting held October 1, 2013, recommending the amendment of Section 22.80 (j) of the LAAC with regards to creating and maintaining an internal and external information and communication network for Neighborhood Council and public use, as detailed in the November 18, 2013 BONC report (attached to the Council file).
2. REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance amending Section 22.80 (j) of the LAAC with regards to creating and maintaining an internal and external information and communication network for Neighborhood Council and public use, as detailed in the November 18, 2013 BONC report (attached to the Council file).
3. INCLUDE the City Clerk as part of the team that will review the materials of how the information network can be hosted and how people can gain access to pertinent information.
