EDUCATION AND NEIGHBORHOODS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Exhaustive Effort process for the Neighborhood Councils.

Recommendations for Council action:

- 3. INSTRUCT the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment (DONE) to provide a supplemental report on the survey given out to the Neighborhood Councils with information on the comments given by the respondents.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on March 18, 2014, the Education and Neighborhoods Committee considered the December 12, 2013 Department of Neighborhood Empowerment (DONE) report relative to the Exhaustive Effort process for the Neighborhood Councils.
