REGARDING: LOS FELIZ VILLAGE MERCHANT-BASED BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT RECONFIRMATION PROCEDURE

Honorable Members:

On December 12, 1997, the City Council adopted Ordinance 171,866, which established the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District, located in Council Districts 4 and 13 (CF 10-1504). The City is required to conduct reconfirmation proceedings in order to levy a special assessment, which supports each year of District operations. The Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District completed its twelfth operating year on December 31, 2013. The Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District advisory Board has approved and submitted an Annual Report and is ready to proceed with the reconfirmation of the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District. The Annual Report for the Business Improvement District's thirteenth operating year, beginning January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014, is presented with this Report for Council consideration as "Attachment 1."

RECONFIRMATION PROCESS

The reconfirmation process consists of the adoption of an Ordinance of Intention, the approval of the Annual Report from the District's management entity and a public hearing prior to the adoption of an Ordinance, which would authorize the special assessment to fund operations for the next year of the program. We have received and reviewed the Annual Report as approved and submitted by the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District Advisory Board and as required by law (Section 36533, California Streets and Highways Code). The report includes the various programs and activities, which would be supported by assessment revenue and interest earnings.

PROPOSED BUDGET

The proposed budget for the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District's 2014 operating year is \$78,350.00. A copy of the budget is included in the Annual Report in "Attachment 1."

PROPOSED DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

The Los Feliz Village BID's boundaries for its 2014 operating year remain unchanged from the BID's 2013 operating year and are generally described as Hillhurst Avenue, from Los Feliz Boulevard on the north to Sunset Boulevard on the south; Hollywood Boulevard, from Hillhurst Avenue on the east to Vermont Avenue on the west; and Vermont Avenue, from Hollywood Boulevard on the south to Franklin Avenue on the north. A map illustrating the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District's boundaries for its 2014 operating year is included as well as a complete description of the boundaries in the Annual Report (Attachment 1).

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS AND PROGRAMS

The Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District's activities and programs for the 2014 operating year include, but are not limited to: Beautification, Communication, Marketing and Public Relations, and other activities, which would be supported by assessment revenue and are described in its Annual Report (Attachment 1).

ASSESSMENT METHODOLOGY

The assessment methodology for the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District is based on the type of business being conducted and the number of full-time employees working in the business. The assessments range by categories from \$100 to \$550 annually. The assessment rates determined by this assessment methodology reflect the specific benefits to the payors from the services provided.

A full description of the assessment methodology with the classification of businesses and assessment schedule is included in the Annual Report (Attachment 1).

DISTRICT ADVISORY BOARD

The District will be governed by an advisory board consisting of business owners. The advisory board provides general oversight of District operations, prepares annual reports and makes recommendations to the City Council on District budget and other issues. The Advisory Board is required to be appointed by the City Council pursuant to Section 36530 of the Streets and Highways Code. The City Council may designate existing advisory boards or commissions to serve as the advisory board for the District or may create a new advisory board for that purpose. A list of the proposed District's current advisory board members is attached.

EXEMPTION UNDER PROPOSITION 26

On November 2, 2010, voters in the State of California passed Proposition 26, which broadened the definition of taxes and which require approval by two-thirds of each house of the Legislature or by local voter approval. However, Proposition 26 provides for exemptions.

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Under Proposition 26, assessments for specific benefits are not defined as taxes and are exempt under Article XIII C §1(e)(1) which states "A charge imposed for a specific benefit conferred or privilege granted directly to the payor that is not provided to those not charged, and which does not exceed the reasonable costs to the local government of conferring the benefit or granting the privilege". For the City Council to find that the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District is exempt from Proposition 26, it must find that 1) the assessment dollars are used in a manner that creates a clear and direct link between the services provided and the benefit to the assessment and services; and 3) the assessment imposed does not exceed the reasonable cost to the local government of conferring the benefit.

The assessments for the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District are used to provide specific benefits directly to the payor. The specific benefit to the payor are the beautification programs, communication services, marketing and public relations services, and administration services which will be provided directly to assessed businesses within the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District. These services will in turn, provide specific benefits to the payors in the form of overall improved area aesthetics which will result in an increase in customers and visitors to the district. This will in turn, result in the increase of retail and commercial business to payors located within the District boundaries. The services are funded solely by the assessments collected and are provided only to the businesses which pay the assessments or to businesses located outside of the District boundaries. Such services cannot be provided without charging the assessment. Furthermore, the assessments are calculated based on the reasonable cost of providing the services to the payor and thus, do not exceed the reasonable cost to the local government in conferring the benefit.

Government Code section 53758 was recently enacted to, among other things, clarify the definition of specific benefit. The discussion provided herein regarding the specific benefit to payors is consistent with Government Code section 53758.

CONTRACTING WITH NON-PROFIT SERVICE PROVIDER

Upon the establishment of the District, State law requires that the City enter into an agreement with an Owners' Association for the administration of the District. City policy dictates that competitive bidding requirements are to be met when contracting. However, Charter section 371(e)(10) provides an exception to the competitive bidding requirements, and states, in relevant part, that the competitive bidding process does not apply to contracts "where the contracting authority finds that the use of competitive bidding would be undesirable, impractical or impossible or where the common law otherwise excuses compliance with competitive bidding requirements."

From its first operating year, the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District has been administered by the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement Corporation, a California non-profit mutual benefit corporation, which oversees expenditures and

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manages and implements improvements and activities related to the Business Improvement District. Through its longstanding presence in the Los Feliz Village community and as administrator of the Business Improvement District during its twelve years of operation, the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement Corporation possesses unique knowledge and expertise of the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District and has a vested interest in its success, therefore it would be undesirable and impractical to comply with the competitive bidding requirements or to select another entity to administer the District.

ASSESSABLE CITY PROPERTY

There is one (1) City-owned property located within the Los Feliz Village BID boundaries. Because the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District is a merchant-based Business Improvement District, there are no assessments to be paid for these City-owned properties.

FISCAL IMPACT

This is a merchant-based Business Improvement District and there are no assessments for City-owned properties within the Business Improvement District, therefore there is no impact on the General Fund.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. FIND that the assessments imposed by the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District for the 2014 fiscal year provide services that directly benefit each of the businesses which pay the assessments.
- 2. FIND that the services funded by the assessment are provided only to each of the assessed businesses within the boundaries of the District.
- 3. FIND that the assessment imposed does not exceed the reasonable cost of conferring the benefits.
- 4. Find that the proposed improvements and activities are completely separate from the day to day operations of the City of Los Angeles.
- 5. FIND that the assessments for the proposed business based District are not taxes and that the District qualifies for exemption from Proposition 26 under exemption 1 of Article XIII C §1(e)(1).
- 6. FIND that the services to be provided by the Owners' Association are in the nature of professional, expert, technical or other special services, that the services are of a temporary and occasional character, and that the use of competitive bidding would be impractical, not advantageous, undesirable or where the common law otherwise excuses compliance with competitive bidding requirements.

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- 7. ADOPT an Ordinance of Intention confirming the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District Annual Report and levying an annual assessment for the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District's thirteenth operating year, January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014.
- 8. DIRECT the City Clerk to schedule, prepare, publish, and mail the public hearing notice, as required by the provisions of Section 36500 et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code.
- 9. INSTRUCT the City Clerk, subject to approval by the City Attorney as to form and legality, to prepare an enabling Ordinance levying the special assessment for the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District's thirteenth operating period beginning January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014.
- 10. APPROVE the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement Corporation, a California non-profit mutual benefit corporation, to administer the proposed services of the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District pursuant to Section 36500 et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code and City regulations.
- 11. AUTHORIZE the City Clerk, subject to City Attorney approval, to prepare, execute, and administer a contract between the City and the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement Corporation to administer the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District, if the Ordinance reconfirming the Business Improvement District is adopted.
- 12. APPOINT the attached Advisory Board.

Fiscal Year of Report: This report covers the period from January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014.

Boundaries: The Los Feliz Village BID's boundaries for its 2014 operating year remain unchanged from the BID's 2013 operating year and are described as follows:

Hillhurst Avenue, from Los Feliz Boulevard on the north to Hollywood Boulevard on the south (1500 - 2100 blocks); Hollywood Boulevard, from Hillhurst Avenue on the east to Vermont Avenue on the west (4400 - 4700 blocks); Vermont Avenue, from Hollywood Boulevard on the south to Franklin Avenue on the north (1600 - 1800 blocks); 4400 - 4700 Ambrose Avenue;4647, 4651, 4655 Kingswell Avenue; 4456, 4500 Los Feliz Boulevard; 4452, 4647, 4651, 4657 Melbourne Avenue; 4647, 4649, 4655 Russell Avenue; 4473 Sunset Drive; Franklin Avenue, Russell Avenue, Melbourne Avenue, Kingswell Avenue and Prospect Avenue on the east and west sides of Vermont Avenue for a distance of 25 yards; Avocado Street, Ambrose Avenue, Price Street, Finley Avenue, Clarissa Avenue, Franklin Avenue, Russell Avenue, Melbourne Avenue, Kingswell Avenue, Prospect Avenue, Camero Avenue, Clayton Avenue and Sunset on the east and west sides of Hillhurst Avenue for a distance of 25 yards. A map illustrating the Los Feliz Village BID's boundaries for its 2014 operating year is attached.

- **Benefit Zones**: The benefit zones for the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District will for its 2014 operating year remain unchanged from the BID's 2013 operating year. There is only one benefit zone.
- Improvements and Activities for 2014: The following are the improvements and activities planned for the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District:
 - 1) **Beautification**: Clean Street is the vendor for trash collection. Trash collection is on a 2 day per week schedule and may be increased as needed. Since 2010, the Board has approved trimming the trees every three years.
 - 2) Communication: The LFVBID website (www.losfeliz.biz) contains community and LFVBID related information. The communication has hired a social media liaison to update our face book page, twitter, enhance our web site, etc. Newsletters will be published on a quarterly basis. They will be distributed to all BID members via

e-blast, and will be available and on the website. Updated information will be distributed via email. The Business Directory will be updated this year.

- 3) Marketing and Public Relations: The 20th Annual Street Fair was held September 7th, 2013. The Holiday Festival was not held for 2013 but we plan to resume it in 2014. Two mixers were held in 2013 with great success. The mixer will be used as the annual public meeting with the members because it is our experience that attendance at the mixers is greater than for Board meetings. Besides mixers we also held one evening public forum to give every BID member the opportunity to attend the meeting.
- **Total Estimate of Costs for 2014**: A breakdown of the total estimated 2014 budget is attached to this report as Appendix A.

Business Type Definitions:

Retail: Businesses that exclusively or partially derive income from the sale of goods and services to the public.

Restaurant: Businesses that sell prepared foods and drinks.

Theaters: Includes motion picture and performing arts theaters.

Banks: Includes banks, savings and loans and credit unions.

Non-profits: Organizations incorporated as non-profit corporations.

Office/Professional Services: Personal/professional services businesses (e.g., attorneys, chiropractors, CPAs) with a total of no more than two people employed by the business, including the provider of the professional services.

- Amount of Surplus/Deficit from previous Fiscal Year: Based on projected expenditures for the 2013 fiscal year the District is expected to not have a surplus to be carried over into the 2014 fiscal year.
- Amount of Contributions from other sources: At this time, the District does not anticipate receiving contributions from other sources.
- New Businesses: New businesses that open within the LFVBID after the ordinance for levying assessments for 2014 has been adopted by the Los Angeles City Council will be exempt from the 2014 assessment; they will be subject to assessments in future years.

1. BID assessment will be based on business size as determined by the number of full time or full time equivalent employees (e.g., two half time employees = one full time employee), agents, or subcontractors working or based at the business premises within the BID.

2. Assessment for business owners with multiple business licenses at the same address will be based on the single highest category (e.g., assessment for retail and profession/occupation licenses for the same business owner at the same address will be set at the retail assessment level).

3. Business owners with multiple business locations within the BID will be assessed separately at each location.

4. Multiple independent business owners at the same address will be assessed separately at their respective rates, except those businesses set up under a master broker or business manager such as realtors, insurance offices, beauty/barber and nail shops/parlors where each agent or subletting individual will be considered an "employees" of the master broker or business manager whose BID assessment will be based on the total number of such agents or subletting individuals.

5. Chase Bank and the Shell Station on Hollywood/Vermont will have a reduced assessment of \$250 each due to unique services that the LFVBID provides and their dual membership with the East Hollywood BID.

6. Non-profits will be assessed at \$100 and Office/Professional services with no more than 2 employees will be assessed at \$100.



ORDINANCE NO.

An Ordinance of Intention of the City of Los Angeles to confirm the Annual Report for the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District (District) and to levy a special assessment upon businesses located within the District for the District's thirteenth operating year beginning January 1, 2014.

WHEREAS, the Parking and Improvement Area Law of 1989, as contained in Sections 36500 *et. seq.* of the California Streets and Highways Code (Act) authorizes the establishment of parking and business improvement districts for the purpose of levying assessments on district businesses for certain purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on December 12, 1997, adopted Ordinance No. 171,866, which established the District and authorized the levy of a special assessment to support District operations for the District's first operating year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 36500 *et seq*. of the Act, an annual report is required to be prepared for each operating year for which assessments are to be levied and collected; and

WHEREAS, the Advisory Board for the District has caused to be prepared and filed the required annual report, which includes a description of programs and activities and any changes or modifications for the District's thirteenth operating year; and,

WHEREAS, the subject annual report complies with the provisions of Section 36533 of the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. DECLARATION OF INTENTION. Pursuant to provisions of the Act, the City Council hereby declares its intention to confirm and approve the Annual Report for the District's thirteenth operating year, prepared by the Advisory Board for Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District which is filed with the City Clerk and is contained in Council File No. ______, to provide for the levy of assessments upon businesses operating within the Los Feliz Village Business Improvement District during the 2014 operating year, and to adopt an ordinance to that effect. Assessments will be levied on and collected from all businesses located within the District in the amounts and according to the classifications set forth in the Annual Report prepared by the District's Advisory Board and filed with the City Clerk. These levies may be based on proposed changes to the district boundaries, to district benefit zones and/or to the basis and method of levying assessments within the District in accord with Section 36533 of the Act.

Sec. 2. DISTRICT BOUNDARIES. The boundaries of the District for the 2014 operating year remain unchanged from the boundaries as set forth for the 2013 operating year. A description of the boundaries of the District for 2014 are as follows: Hillhurst Avenue, from Los Feliz Boulevard on the north to Sunset Boulevard on the south; Hollywood Boulevard, from Hillhurst Avenue on the east to Vermont Avenue on the west; and Vermont Avenue, from Hollywood Boulevard on the south to Franklin Avenue on the north. A full description of the boundaries and a map are included in the Annual Report on file with the City Clerk and contained in Council File No.

Sec. 3. IMPROVEMENTS AND ACTIVITIES. The improvements and activities to be funded by the assessments may include, but are not limited to Beautification, Communication, Marketing/Public Relations, Administration/Bookkeeping and other activities as identified in Sections 36510 and 36513 of the Act.

Sec. 4. METHOD AND BASIS FOR LEVYING ASSESSMENT. The proposed method and basis for levying the assessment is set forth in the Annual Report filed with the City Clerk. Except where funds are otherwise available, an assessment to pay for all specified improvements and activities within the District will be levied annually following a public hearing and adoption of a resolution by the City Council.

Sec. 5. PUBLIC HEARING. Pursuant to Section 36524 of the Act, one public hearing shall be held before the City Council. The public hearing shall be held on ________at 10:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter may be heard, in the John Ferraro Council Chamber in Room 340 at City Hall, 200 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, California 90012. The public hearing shall be held not less than ten days after the adoption of the Ordinance of Intention. The public hearing may be continued from time to time. At this hearing, the City Council will consider the adoption of the ordinance authorizing the assessment for the District's 2014 operating year.

Sec. 6. PROTESTS. At the public hearing, the City Council shall hear and consider all protests against the proposed levying of the assessment on businesses located within the District for the subject operating year, the extent of the District, or the furnishing of specified types of improvements or activities within the District. A protest may be made orally or in writing by any interested person. Any protest pertaining to the regularity or sufficiency of the proceedings shall be in writing and shall clearly set forth the irregularity or defect to which the objection is made.

Every written protest shall be filed with the City Clerk prior to or during the public hearing. The City Council may waive any irregularity in the form or content of any written protest and at the public hearing may correct minor defects in the proceedings. A written protest may be withdrawn in writing at any time prior to the conclusion of the public hearing.

Each written protest shall contain a description of the business in which the person subscribing the protest is interested sufficient to identify the business and, if a

person subscribing is not shown on the official records of the City as the owner of the business, the protest shall contain or be accompanied by written evidence that the person subscribing is the owner of the business. A written protest that does not comply with these requirements shall not be counted in determining a majority protest.

Written protests can be on a form supplied by the City Clerk (Form SAS 143B). The form may be obtained at the Council and Public Services public counter in Room 395 at City Hall, 200 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, California 90012 or by telephoning (213) 978-1099.

If written protests are received from the owners of businesses in the District who will pay 50% or more of the assessments proposed to be levied and protests are not withdrawn so as to reduce the protests to less than 50%, no further proceedings to levy the proposed assessment shall be taken for a period of one year from the date of the finding of a majority protest by the City Council.

If the majority protest is only against the furnishing of a specified type or types of improvement or activity within the District, those types of improvements or activities shall be eliminated.

Sec. 7. QUESTIONS OR COMMENTS. Any person having a question or comment regarding the hearing proceedings may telephone (213) 978-1099 [facsimile (213) 978-1130] and address the questions or comments to the Deputy City Clerk assigned to answer inquiries regarding the hearing proceedings.

Sec. 8. NOTICE REQUIREMENT. The City Clerk is directed to give notice of the public hearing pursuant to Section 36523 of the Act.

Sec. 9. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
