Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Cedillo - Huizar), SUBJECT TO

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2013-14 State Legislative
Program SUPPORT for AB 1750 (Alejo), which would require the Instructional Quality
Commission to establish a task force to identify and report on appropriate curricula for
establishing and implementing ethnic studies in public high schools statewide.

Summary:

At its regular meeting of March 21, 2014, the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental
Relations Committee considered a CLA report and Resolution (Cedillo - Huizar) relative to the
