





La Ciudad de Los Angeles ofrece una recompensa pagadera a la discreción del Concejo de la Ciudad a una o más personas por la suma o hasta una cantidad en conjunto de \$50,000 por información que conduzca a la identificación y detención de la persona o personas responsables por un ATROPELLAMIENTO FATAL Y HUADA DE DAVID PREGERSON, en la Ciudad de Los Angeles. El viernes 27 de diciembre de 2013, aproximadamente a las 3:00 a.m., un accidente de tráfico de atropellamiento y huída ocurrió en Chautauqua Boulevard, al norte de Borgos Place. Un vehículo desconocido se dirigió hacia el sur en Chautauqua Boulevard y colisionó con David Pregerson de 23 años de edad, que se encontraba en la calzada. El conductor del carro continuó su marcha hacia el sur en Chautauqua Boulevard, y no se detuvo a prestar ayuda o a identificarse a sí mismo/misma. El personal del Departamento de Bomberos de Los Angeles respondió y transportó al Sr. Pregerson a un hospital local, donde el 21 de diciembre de 2013, alrededor de las 10:00 a.m., murió a consecuencia de sus heridas. Los detectives no han podido localizar al sospechoso y esperan que una recompensa motivará a los posibles testigos a presentarse. La persona o personas responsables de este delito representan una amenaza constante para la seguridad de los habitantes de Los Angeles. A menos que se retire o se pague la acción por medio del Concejo de la Ciudad, esta oferta de recompensa terminará y no tendrá ningún efecto posterior al 5 DE OCTUBRE DE 2014.
