REQUEST FOR AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS FROM THE MOBILE SOURCE AIR POLLUTION REVIEW COMMITTEE (MSRC) PROGRAM FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING INFRASTRUCTURE

The Department of General Services (GSD) applied for and was awarded \$102,995 in grant funds to install 42 new electric vehicle (EV) charging stations at City-owned parking locations in the civic center. A project match in the same amount is required of the City. Sufficient funds are available within the Water and Electricity Fund to meet this match.

The MSRC grant funds will help support objectives of previously adopted Council actions related to EVs, sustainability, and reduction of greenhouse gas emissions. This project is also in accordance with the Mayor's Sustainable City pLAN initiative to install more than 1,000 new publicly available EV charging stations, including more than 100 on City property to improve air quality in the region. Therefore, GSD requests the City Council to adopt the following recommendations to accept and expend grant funds offered for the above referenced project.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor:


1. Authorize the GSD General Manager to accept and expend on behalf of the City, a grant in the amount of \$102,995 from the MSRC to be used as payment for the above electric vehicle infrastructure project.
2. Authorize the appropriation of \$102,995 in prior year encumbrances from the Water and Electricity Fund 60/100, Account 00083 to the Department of General Services 40/100 Contractual Services Account 003040 for the above electric vehicle infrastructure project.



3. Authorize the GSD General Manager or designee to prepare Controller instructions and/or make any technical adjustments that may be required and are consistent with the above action subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer and authorize the Controller to implement these instructions.

4. Authorize the GSD General Manager or designee to negotiate and execute on behalf of the City grant contracts, agreements and amendments with grantor agencies and contractors as necessary to fully implement the above electric vehicle infrastructure project, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.
