

SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF MONETARY DONATION

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

1. That the Board of Police Commissioners (Board) APPROVE the Department's Report and TRANSMIT to the Mayor and City Council for ACCEPTANCE the donation in the amount of \$67,634.08 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation to support overtime, uniforms, and office supplies for officers and students from Operations-South Bureau's Juvenile Impact Program.
2. That the Board AUTHORIZE the Controller to deposit the monetary donation of \$67,634.08 to the Police Department Trust Fund 885, Department 70, Revenue Source 5102 and TRANSFER the same amount to Fund 100, Department 70, Revenue Source 5301.
3. That the Board AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Police Department to prepare Controller's instructions for any technical adjustments consistent with this action, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer; and, REQUEST that the Controller implement the instructions.


