PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a monetary donation for use by Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Operations - South Bureau's Juvenile Impact Program.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept a monetary donation in the amount of \$67,634.08 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for use by LAPD for overtime, uniforms, and office supplies for officers and students from the Department's Operations - South Bureau's Juvenile Impact Program, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.
- 2. AUTHORIZE the Controller to deposit the monetary donation of \$67,634.08 to the Police Department Trust Fund 885/70, Revenue Source 5102, and TRANSFER the same amount to Fund 100/70, Revenue Source 5301.
- 3. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to prepare Controller's instructions for any technical adjustments consistent with this action, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO); and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

## <u>SUMMARY</u>

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated April 11, 2014 (attached to the Council file), the LAPD requests authority to accept a monetary donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the Department's Operations - South Bureau's Juvenile Impact Program. The donation will be used to pay for teacher's salaries and overtime for officers directly in support of the program. The donated funds will also be used to purchase uniforms for the students, utility bags, graduation supplies, composition notebooks, and the school site fee and insurance. On April 15, 2014, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At its meeting held June 27, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation and to approve the related actions above, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners.
