

DISCUSSION

The donation is for the benefit of the Los Angeles Police Department's (Department) Central Traffic Division (CTD). The donation will be used to educate the community on traffic safety, specifically pedestrian and bicycle safety, Hit and Run, and Distracted Driving. The equipment will enable CTD to produce high quality, impactful public service announcements in an effort to promote the "2014 Year of Traffic." In addition, CTD will assist the William H. Parker Foundation with a short video to publicize their function and benefit to the Department and community.

The equipment is warrantied from the manufacturer for a period of one year. Replacement parts pertaining to light bulbs are included in the cost. Officer Cynthia Dominguez, Information Technology Bureau (ITB), has approved the use of the equipment by the Department. If any data storage services are necessary at a later date, any fees incurred will not be covered by ITB.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patents.
