SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF MONETARY DONATION

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

1. That the Board of Police Commissioners (Board) ACCEPT and TRANSMIT to the Mayor and City Council a donation in the amount of \$20,000.00 from the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Youth Welfare and Education Fund to support sworn and civilian overtime for the operation and administration of the Cadet Program.
2. That the Board AUTHORIZE the LAPD to deposit, for sworn overtime, \$10,000.00 to Donations Trust Fund 885, Department 70, Revenue Source 4513 and TRANSFER the same amount to Fund 100, Department 70, Revenue Source 1092.
3. That the Board AUTHORIZE the LAPD to deposit, for civilian overtime, \$10,000.00 to Donations Trust Fund 885, Department 70, Revenue Source 4513 and TRANSFER the same amount to Fund 100, Department 70, Revenue Source 1090.
4. That the Board AUTHORIZE the LAPD to prepare Controller's instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer, and REQUEST that the Controller implement the instructions.


SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR ACCEPTANCE OF DONATION FOR OVERTIME

It is requested that Administrative and Technical Services Bureau accept the following donation on behalf of the Los Angeles Police Department, Office of Operations, Youth Programs Unit.

A donation from the LAPD Youth Welfare and Education Fund in the amount of \$20,000 was received by Fiscal Operations Division on May 13, 2014 to benefit the Office of Operations, Youth Programs Unit.
