DISCUSSION

The donation would enable the Los Angeles Police Department (Department) to implement Phase II of the DICVS. This would entail the installation of cameras in patrol vehicles in the Department's Operations-Central Bureau, Operations-West Bureau and Operations-Valley Bureau. Implementing the DICVS in the remaining geographic bureaus would benefit the entire City by providing quicker and more credible adjudications of personnel complaints and administrative investigations.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patents.




