PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of a 2014 Dodge Grand Caravan for use by the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Gang and Narcotics Division.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept the donation of a 2014 Dodge Grand Caravan, radio, and storage lock boxes, valued at \$30,000 from the United States Department of Justice and the United States Marshal Service (USMS) for use by the LAPD's Gang and Narcotics Division, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Officer has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

<u>SUMMARY</u>

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept the donation of a 2014 Dodge Grand Caravan. LAPD states that the vehicle will be used in a joint LAPD/USMS task force for surveillance and apprehension of violent fugitives in the City of Los Angeles. The radio and storage lock boxes will be installed by an outside vendor selected by the USMS. On August 19, 2014, the Board approved the Department's request.

At its special meeting held October 1, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation.
