PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of the Leica Scanstation C10 Laser Scanning System for use by the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Force Investigation Division.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept the donation of the Leica Scanstation C10 Laser Scanning System valued at \$133,899.70 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation, for use by the LAPD's Force Investigation Division, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Officer has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated August 29, 2014 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept the donation of the Leica Scanstation C10 Laser Scanning System. The Leica ScanStation C10 is a laser scanning system and when activated emits laser beams that record reference points at a rate of over 50,000 points per second. The scanner also takes hundreds of high definition panoramic photographs that, when combined with recorded points of reference, result in a perfect three dimensional re-creation of the crime scene. The donation will be used by LAPD's Force Investigation Division which is responsible for investigating all Categorical Uses of Force and has been tasked with documenting the scenes of these critical incidents. On September 9, 2014, the Board approved the Department's request.

At its meeting held December 12, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation.
