PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of landscaping products and services for use by the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Foothill Area.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept the donation of landscaping products and services valued at \$32,190.00 from the Foothill Area Boosters Association, Inc., for use by the LAPD's Foothill Area, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Officer has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

<u>SUMMARY</u>

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated October 24, 2014 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept the donation of landscaping products and services. The donation will be used to improve the exterior appearance of the Foothill Area station. The items will allow drought tolerant, low maintenance landscaping in the front of the station and hardscape to the rear. Local non-profit groups will provide volunteers to assist with the planting. On November 4, 2014, the Board approved the Department's request.

At its meeting held December 12, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation.
