

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of a four-camera wireless surveillance system for use by the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Southwest Area.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept the donation of a four-camera wireless surveillance system valued at \$80,627.40 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for use by the LAPD's Southwest Area, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Officer has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated November 7, 2014 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept the donation of a four-camera wireless surveillance system. The cameras will cover four entry/exit points in the Baldwin Hills Estate Area. The donation will augment and integrate into an existing surveillance system. On November 18, 2014, the Board approved the Department's request.

At its meeting held January 23, 2015, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation.
