PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of video and audio equipment for use by the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Central Traffic Division.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept the donation of video and audio equipment valued at \$24,057 from the William H. Parker Foundation for use by the LAPD's Central Traffic Division, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.


SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated December 12, 2014 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept the donation of two electric police motorcycles. The donation will be used to educate the community on traffic safety, specifically pedestrian and bicycle safety, hit and run, and distracted driving. The equipment will enable the Central Traffic Division to produce high quality, impactful public service announcements in an effort to promote the 2014 Year of Traffic. On December 16, 2014, the Board approved the Department's request.

At its meeting held January 23, 2015, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation.
