Dear Councilmembers:

The United Neighborhoods of the Historic Arlington Heights, West Adams and Jefferson Park Communities Neighborhood Council (UNNC) supports Council President Herb Wesson's motion to add the John L. Matheson/Church of Latter Day Saints (LDS) California Mission Residence, located at 2067 S. Hobart Blvd., to the City's list of Historic Cultural Monuments.

Stakeholders to UNNC asked our neighborhood council to support their efforts to designate the property as a historic resource. UNNC's Planning and Land Use Committee and Historic Preservation Committee held a publicly-noticed joint meeting on Wednesday, October 29, 2014 and evaluated the matter, recommending that the UNNC Governing Board support the City's action. On Thursday, November 6, 2014, in a publicly-noticed meeting, the UNNC Governing Board voted to support the property being so designated.

This action is reflected in the minutes of the meeting, excerpted here:

Saints (LDS) California Mission Residence at 2067 S. Hobart an Historic Cultural Monument.
