Dear John and Council Members:

I don't support the Proposals for the Rent Registration for the following reasons:

- 1. A system such as this might be unnecessary as this information may already be available through private companies. Further exploration is required.
- 2. This raises serious privacy concerns as tenant's rental costs will be public. Financials are a very private matter and this could pit tenant against tenant.
- 3. The report's own statistics show that illegal increases are rare. This can be enforced through present mechanisms. Further study of enforcement within the present system is required.
- 4. An education budget is already available to HCIDLA which can be used for better outreach to RSO tenants and providers.
- 5. This will certainly increase rents as a new government system and registration costs will be passed through to tenants.
