Recommendation for Council action:

INSTRUCT the Department of City Planning (DCP), in coordination with the Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety and the Los Angeles Housing and Community Investment Department, to implement administrative changes to the current demolition process, as identified in Option 3 of the DCP's Supplemental Report dated September 21, 2017, attached to the Council file.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the DCP. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

## **Summary**:

At a meeting held on September 27, 2017, the Housing Committee considered a report from the DCP dated September 21, 2017 relative to possible zoning code, administrative, and regulatory recommendations to strengthen enforcement of the Rent Stabilization Ordinance and Ellis Act provisions.
