DEVELOPER AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES HARBOR DEPARTMENT

AND COGNAC PACIFIC GATEWAY, LLC, FTZ 202, MAGNET SITE 7

Pursuant to Section 373 of the City Charter and Section 10.5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, enclosed for your approval is Resolution No. 18-8398 authorizing proposed Second Amendment Agreement No. 18-2723-B between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and Cognac Pacific Gateway, LLC (Cognac); which was approved at the December 18, 2018 meeting of the Board of Harbor Commissioners. The proposed Second Amendment will allow Cognac to maintain its Foreign-Trade Zone (FTZ) status on property located at the southwest corner of Vermont Avenue and 190<sup>th</sup> Street in Torrance, California. The site includes multiple warehouses and office buildings within 93 acres of Magnet Site 7. If the proposed Second Amendment is approved, the Harbor Department will receive \$7,750 annually from Cognac. There is no impact to the General Fund.

## RECOMMENDATION FOR CITY COUNCIL:

- 1. ADOPT the determination by the Board of Harbor Commissioners (Board) that the proposed action is administratively exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with Article II, Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines;
- 2. APPROVE Harbor Department Resolution No. 18-8398 authorizing proposed Second Amendment Agreement No. 18-2723-B between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and Cognac Pacific Gateway, LLC; and
- 3. Return to the Board of Harbor Commissioners for further processing.
