

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to resolution authority for nine positions in the Department of Cannabis Regulation (DCR) to support the Social Equity Program and other DCR functions related to cannabis regulation.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

RESOLVE that the following positions in the DCR are APPROVED and CONFIRMED for the period of November 16, 2018 to June 30, 2019, to support the Social Equity Program, licensing and compliance programs, and other functions related to regulating cannabis businesses within the City of Los Angeles, subject to position allocation by the Board of Civil Service Commissioners and pay grade determination by the Office of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), Employee Relations Division.
