

I MOVE that the matter of the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee Report relative to a social equity analysis of cannabis regulations aimed at promoting equitable ownership and employment opportunities in the cannabis industry; and, requesting the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance establishing a Social Equity Program for recreational cannabis dispensaries, Item 5 on today's Council Agenda, (CF's - 17-0653 and 14-0366-S15) **BE AMENDED** to also adopt the following changes to the Committee recommendations:

- 1) REMOVE Recommendations 1(f)(iv)(1)(a) through 1(f)(iv)(1)(d) and additional references in 1(d)(iv)(1)(b), 1(d)(v)(1)(a), 1(f)(iii)(2), and anywhere else in the recommendations relative to Commercial Cannabis Businesses contributing a percentage of their annual gross receipts to the Community Reinvestment and Benefit Program Fund; and
- 2) INSTRUCT the Department of Cannabis Regulation, the City Administrative Officer, and the Chief Legislative Analyst, with the assistance of the City Attorney, to report back no later than January 12, 2018, with proposals to fund the Community Reinvestment and Benefit Program Fund.
