As requested by City Council, this Office previously prepared and transmitted for your consideration three draft ordinances adding: Article 4 to Chapter X of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to regulate commercial cannabis activities in the City; rules and regulations to support the City's implementation and administration of the new Commercial Cannabis licensing ordinance; and Article 5 to Chapter X of the LAMC to limit the location and permissibility of specified cannabis activities in the City of Los Angeles. This Office has revised the draft ordinances as requested by the City Council, approved them as to form and legality, and now transmits the draft ordinances for your consideration.


Council Rule 38 Referral
