


MOTION

I MOVE that the matter of COMMUNICATION FROM THE CITY ATTORNEY and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) regarding commercial cannabis activity, Item 28 on today's Council Agenda (C.F. 14-0366-S5), BE AMENDED to Receive and File the City Attorney Draft Report and Ordinance dated May 28, 2019 and to request the City Attorney to Prepare and present an ordinance to achieve the following:


1. An applicant with a Business Premises located in an area of Undue Concentration must meet all previously adopted sensitive use requirements as established under Article 5 of Chapter X of this Code and shall meet the qualifying criteria under Section 104.06.1 (c) (1)-(2), and shall comply with subsection (g) in addition to a finding by the City Council that such approval of the License application would serve a public convenience or necessity pursuant to Section 104.03. An application processed under this subsection shall begin no later than September 3, 2019.
  
2. DELETE Section 104.06.1 (e)

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Attorney be REQUESTED to amend all other language not in conformance with the above recommendations and to return a draft ordinance to City Council no later than June 27, 2019.
