Re: Council File No. 14-0366-S5 CAO/CLA Staff Report Relative to Proposition D

This letter addresses the August 18, 2016 report by the Chief Legislative Analyst and City Administrative Officer, which sets forth various Prop D legislative amendment options for the cannabis industry in the City of Los Angeles. We thank you, the CLA, the CAO, and Andrew Westall, for taking a leadership role in this important issue. After reading your staff report, it is clear that considerable time and resources were spent outlining and addressing the regulatory challenges in the cannabis industry. It does an excellent job identifying the different cannabis businesses seeking licensure from the City and proposing various options for moving forward.

Creating a regulatory framework and licensing scheme for this industry is a difficult and daunting task. We believe that businesses and local stakeholders need to also take a leadership role in this process. As we understand from comments made at the August 19th public hearing, this is your desire as well.
