

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to authorize the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) to disconnect utility services at unlawful commercial cannabis establishments.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE, dated February 28, 2019, amending Section 104.5 of Article 4, Chapter 10 of the LAMC to authorize the LADWP to disconnect utility services at unlawful commercial cannabis establishments.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on March 5, 2019, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a City Attorney Report and Ordinance, dated February 28, 2019, relative to amending the LAMC to authorize the LADWP to disconnect utility services at unlawful commercial cannabis establishments.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the Ordinance. This matter is now forwarded to Council for its consideration.
