**MOTION PUBLIC WORKS & GANG REDUCTION**

The streets around schools within the City of Los Angeles, particularly elementary schools, are often very chaotic during pick-up and drop-off time, and they can be potentially dangerous for students and parents.

Compounding this problem is the fact that many of those same streets have parking restrictions in order to facilitate street sweeping, thus eliminating a substantial amount of available parking and causing more crowding and more potentially dangerous illegal parking in some areas.

Further, street sweeping restrictions often begin at 8:00 a.m., leaving inadequate time for parents to drop off their children and return to their cars before becoming vulnerable to ticketing.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council INSTRUCT the Bureau of Street Services and Department of Transportation to report on the feasibility of limiting street sweeping no-parking restrictions, on streets near elementary schools, to begin only after 8:30 a.m., and include an estimate of costs that would be incurred in changing the signage to facilitate the change in policy.
