Subject: AUTHORITY TO APPLY, ACCEPT, NEGOTIATE, AND EXECUTE AGREEMENTS FOR CONTRACT FUNDING FROM LEONARDO TECHNOLOGIES, INC. AND/OR A NEW U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY, PRIME CONTRACTOR FOR ALTERNATIVE FUEL VEHICLE PROGRAMMATIC SUPPORT OF THE LOS ANGELES CLEAN CITIES COALITION

As recommended in the accompanying report of the Director of the Bureau of Sanitation, which this Board has adopted, the Board of Public Works requests that the City Council, subject to concurrence of the Mayor, authorize the Director of the Bureau of Sanitation, or his designee to apply, accept, negotiate, and execute all documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, and amendments, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality, which might be necessary to secure contract funds in an amount not to exceed \$30,000 for alternative fuel vehicle programmatic support for the period, November 16, 2014 until November 15, 2015.

It is also requested, to authorize the Bureau of Sanitation to continue to participate in the Clean Cities Program by completing the re-designation process from the U.S. Department of Energy (U.S. DOE) during the fiscal year 2015-16; authorize the Bureau of Sanitation to receive contract funds from Leonardo Technologies, Inc. (LTI) and/or the other selected U.S. DOE vendor and appropriate up to \$30,000 into the Environmental Affairs Trust Fund, Fund 537, Dept. 50, Account (FY 2015 Clean Cities – Programmatic Support); authorize the Bureau of Sanitation to transfer and appropriate \$30,000 from the Environmental Affairs Trust Fund, Fund 537, Dept. 50, Account FY 2015 Clean Cities – Programmatic Support to Fund 100, Dept. 82, Account 1070, As-Needed Salaries; and to authorize the Controller to make technical corrections as necessary.

### FISCAL IMPACT

There is no impact to the City's General Fund. The Environmental Affairs Trust Fund will front the project and the Trust Fund will be reimbursed by the contract once the tasks of the contract have been completed.
