PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to fabricating honorary street signs at the approximate location for Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) personnel who have been killed during an active fire incident.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Englander - Rodriguez):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to:

- a. Work with the LAFD, the United Firefighters of Los Angeles City, and the LAFD Historical Society to fabricate honorary street signs for all LAFD personnel who have been killed during an active fire incident.
- b. Install the signs in the approximate location of each incident to serve as an ongoing memorial to these brave individuals.
- c. Repair any signs that are damaged within 48 hours.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY
