MOTION

In 2009, the Police Department (LAPD) completed the construction of the Harbor Jail. However, the facility was never opened and has sat dormant for the past ten years. In the 2019-20 Adopted Budget, the Mayor and Council made the re-opening of the Harbor Jail a priority and approved the personnel, maintenance and funds necessary to re-open this facility, including restoring the facility's security system to service. In addition, the Mayor and Council funded other security system upgrades and improvements for other LAPD facilities. The estimated total cost of these projects is approximately \$1.5 million.

On June 5, 2014, after a competitive bid process, the LAPD selected and executed a professional services agreement with ASSI Security, Inc. (Contract No. C-124017) to design, upgrade, supply, and install Security Management Systems (SMS) at Department facilities. The Original Agreement had a contract compensation limit of \$1 million. The LAPD has already expended funds in excess of \$900,000 for this contract. In order to complete the projects included in the 2019-20 Adopted Budget, it is necessary to increase the current contract compensation limit to accommodate the additional expenditures needed to re-open the Harbor Jail and complete other authorized projects. The LAPD recommends a revised contract ceiling amount of \$3 million, which includes contingency expenses. No additional increase in the contract amount is anticipated and all other provisions of the contract will remain as adopted by Council.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police, or his designee, to amend the Professional Services Agreement with ASSI Security, Inc. (Contract No.C-124017) to increase the maximum compensation limit from \$1,000,000 to \$3,000,000, in order to complete the projects included in the 2019-20 Adopted Budget, including the re-opening of the Harbor Jail.
