Summary: The Atwater Village Neighborhood Council would like to voice our support of Council File 14-0655-S8. The Coordinated Entry System (CES) is a crucial piece in the process of connecting unhoused stakeholders with services. Given the difficulty of rehousing those who have fallen into homelessness it must be operating as effectively as possible to connect the unhoused to caseworkers who can guide them towards housing. The CES must be working to build trust between the city and its most vulnerable residents if we are to solve the homelessness crisis, and both stakeholders and service providers have complained about the system's inability to manage the surge in use over the past few years. We encourage the council and LAHSA to move forward with this study to ensure that the system is functioning as intended.
