2015-02-24 Massive construction and grading must stop.

I am urging you to remove Lower Council District 5, Kentwood, and Mar Vista/East Venice from the Proposed ICO for the following three reasons:

- 1) Residents have not been given time to vet this ordinance;
- 2) This ordinance may even promote building box-like structures, which is the very evil that it wants to prevent; and
- 3) This ordinance applies stricter building conditions to our neighborhood as opposed to neighboring areas, which appears unfair and discriminatory.


First, this ICO became public on February 12, just 12 days ago. When this ordinance was first introduced in October, our neighborhoods were not included. The City has not provided the residents with a reasonable amount of time for public outreach and comment. My neighborhood homeowners association (Century Glen) has not disseminated any information about this ICO on their website or otherwise. I started a petition 24 hours ago, in support of removing these neighborhoods from this ICO, and in that short period of time, I have already garnered **7**5 signatures in support of their removal.

Second, this ordinance does not preclude building a bland box and may even encourage building this type of structure to maximize square footage. By so severely restricting residential area by taking away the density bonus and counting garages, porches, patios, and breezeways as habitable living space, it may encourage building maximum area without regard to architectural concerns. The result will be houses that look like two bland boxes on top of one another, albeit smaller, which will have a negative impact to the aesthetics of these neighborhoods anyway.

Third, there is no explanation as to why our neighborhoods have tighter building restrictions than neighboring communities. Not only is the 20% bonus density removed but also now garages among other structures count towards habitable living space. What this does is restrict the buildable area in our neighborhoods to 30% of the lot size while other neighborhoods can build up to 58% of their lot size. This differential treatment appears quite unfair and discriminatory.

In sum, my neighbors and I are working class families part of the sandwich generation. We support aging parents while raising children and often work at home a day or two a week. We too do not want to build or see McMansions in our neighborhoods but we want a home comfortable enough to have bedrooms for ourselves, our children, our parents, and a home office. This ICO deprives us of the ability to expand our homes to suit our basic needs, while maintaining the charm of the neighborhood.

Councilmen Paul Koretz and Mike Bonin are under the impression that most people want stricter limits on the size of new or remodeled homes because that is what is reported in newspapers and what a few vocal residents are pushing. Lower Council District 5, Kentwood, and Mar Vista/East Venice are family friendly neighborhoods comprised mostly of single-story, 1920's and 1930's homes. Residents wish to have the ability to expand these homes to suit their needs, while maintaining the charm of the neighborhood.

Over the past several months, the City of Los Angeles has been working to further restrict buildable area on residential lots, including removal of the density bonus. The City's Planning Department expects to have these new restrictions prepared within 18 months. However, now Councilmen Paul Koretz and Mike Bonin have introduced an Interim Control Ordinance (ICO) that if adopted would immediately restrict construction on residential lots. Of particular concern is that the ICO would apply to most of the Westside including zip codes 90064, 90024, 90025, 90066, 90045, and 90291. This proposed ICO would not only remove the 20% bonus density so that homeowners would only be able to build up to 50% of the size of their lot but now mandatory covered parking, detached accessory buildings, porches, patios, and breezeways would count towards the livable residential floor area. By way of example, construction of a house on a typical lot size of 6,250 square feet would be limited to a maximum of 2,475 square feet of livable interior floor space since required covered parking, detached accessory buildings, porches, patios, and breezeways will count towards habitable living space. It should be further noted that this change in classification of covered parking, detached accessory buildings, porches, patios, and breezeways does not apply in many other areas and this ordinance is therefore creating much stricter restrictions in these zip codes than in many other neighbrhoods to which it applies. In short, this ordinance will deflate our property values compared to our neighboring communities and lower property values means less financial resources for our public school and for other City services.

If you oppose this ICO that would restrict your buildable area to what is really approximately 30% of your lot size and places stricter limits on your neighborhood than others, thereby deflating your property values, then I strongly urge you to sign this petition to voice your opposition to including zip codes 90064, 90024, 90025, 90066, 90045, and 90291 to this Interim Control Ordinance. Time is of the essence as the City plans to pass this ordinance in the next few days.

Gentlemen:

My name is Gary Morris. I am a land use consultant with 12 employees and over 50 years of experience in Los Angeles. My company currently is working on over 100 projects, many of which are large single family home sites in Bel Air Council District 5. I am here today, without pay, to address two issues because the proposed ICO as currently drafted will inflict more harm on more people than any benefit it may bestow to a few that already have what they wish to deprive others from obtaining.

The first issue is simple - the proposed ICO limits cubic yards of exempt grading to 6,000 cubic yards and is a "one size fits all" solution. The problem is this makes no more sense than one size shoes, suits, meals, wages, taxes, families or friends. If 6,000 cubic yards is appropriate for a 6,000 square foot lot how could it be right for 60,000 square foot lot or a 6 acre lot. A sliding scale allowing grading equal to 5% of the lot area plus 6,000 cubic yards is far more equitable. The second issue is equally simple – The proposed ICO exempts projects already in plan check where no subsequent changes have been made to "increase or decrease" their size by more than 5%. All parties are better served by allowing and encouraging decreases to accommodate legitimate concerns. Just limit increases over 5% and everybody wins.

What works for the small lot makes the large lot impractical or impossible to develop. Adding insult to injury, prohibiting large lot development hurts not just the few who can afford it but the many who depend on those few – including my 12 employees, the few dozen consultants we work with (architects, engineers, geologists) and the hundreds, if not thousands whose livelihood depends on the contractors who develop them (painters, plumbers, plasterers, framers, cabinet works etc.) to say nothing of the suppliers.

Therefore if you are going to act, act to fix a problem not create or exacerbate one. Take the 45 days of this ICO and work with the City and the Community to refine or revise the existing BHO.

Members of the Council:

My name is Michael Riehl and I am the owner of Riehl Construction Consulting, LLC. My company acts as owner's representatives for many homeowners throughout the Los Angeles area. I currently have nine employees and have been operating in Los Angeles for over 15 years. My company is currently working on numerous projects that are located in Bel Air Council District No.5.

I understand that you have been receiving complaints regarding the number of hauling trucks that have been traveling through Bel-Air and the adjacent neighborhoods. I agree that the City should impose some type of restrictions to reduce the number of hauling trucks on the road. However, I do not feel that the proposed ordinance is a sensible solution as it does not directly address the amount of dirt that is being imported and exported to and from a property. The proposed ordinance simply restricts the amount of dirt that can be moved on a property, regardless of whether that dirt is imported or exported from the property using heavy trucks.

My objective is to have the ordinance revised so it addresses the complaints that have been filed but also takes into consideration additional factors such as lot size and the amount of dirt actually moved on to or off of the property. It does not seem equitable to apply a 6,000 cubic yard restriction on both a 10,000 square foot property and a 60,000 square foot property. It also does not seem equitable to allow 6,000 cubic yards to be imported onto a site but not allow another owner to move 6,500 yards from one side of their property to the other.

I implore you to take into consideration the hundreds of people you would be effecting when voting on this ICO, including the homeowners whose property would lose value, subcontractors who would lose work, the suppliers who would lose customers, and the employees who would lose jobs. Thank you for your time and attention on this matter.
