ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to Los Angeles Convention Center truck marshaling facilities.

Recommendation for Council action:

INSTRUCT the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), with the City Administrative Officer, City Attorney, and Los Angeles Convention and Tourism Development Department, to enter into negotiations with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and other parties as necessary concerning a long-term lease of properties adjacent to the Los Angeles Convention Center for truck marshaling uses, and report to Council on the outcome of those negotiations.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CLA reports that there would be no impact to the General Fund resulting from this action.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on May 27, 2014, the Economic Development Committee considered a report from the CLA relative to securing truck marshaling facilities for the Los Angeles Convention Center in the event that existing facilities are lost through the demolition of the West Hall and construction of a New Hall and Event Center (NH-EC) and Stadium, or through the expansion of exhibit hall and meeting room space (Plan B) if the NH-EC and Stadium project does not proceed; and authorization to enter into negotiations with Caltrans for land it owns adjacent to the Los Angeles Convention Center to serve as replacement truck marshaling facilities.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee approved the recommendation in the CLA report. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
