On November 13, 2019, the Public Safety Committee considered a November 8, 2019 Department of Animal Services (DAS) report relative to emergency evacuation planning for equine and large animals. After consideration, the Committee moved to recommend the following:

- Request that the Emergency Management Department, DAS, Department of Recreation and Parks, Los Angeles Fire Department and the Los Angeles Police Department report back to the Public Safety committee with a Standard Operating Procedure for Emergency Equine Evacuations. This report should include the roles of each Department, activation procedures, timelines, notification process, response protocols, coordination with the Volunteer Emergency Evacuation Response Team, and recommendations for improvement.
- 2) Request that the DAS, the Department of Planning, Bureau of Sanitation, and Bureau of Engineering create a heat map that reflects a high concentration of equine properties, utilizing data from, but not limited to, horse licenses, all equine keeping zones, and brown bins.
