MOTION

In 2012 the City enacted a parking occupancy tax collection bond (Ordinance No. 182283) to require all auto park operators to post a bond to secure payment of delinquent parking occupancy taxes and to allow the City to pursue all persons responsible for collecting and remitting the parking taxes to the City. The new bond filings were due by the end of October, 2013. There have been some inconsistent filings and compliance issues according to several parking operators.

What is needed is some clarity as to how many bonds were filed with the City since October, and what problems the City offices have observed. The involved offices are the Department of Finance which is responsible for taxes and fees paid to the City, the Police Commission Investigative Division which issues the permits, and the Department of Transportation.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council, with the concurrence of the Mayor, DIRECT the Department of Finance and the Police Commission Investigative Division with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst, to report to the Council within 30 days on the status of the City's new parking occupancy tax collection bond program.
