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

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PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the 2014-15 Operation ABC grant award for use by the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD).

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. AUTHORIZE the Chief, LAPD, or designee, to:
 - a. Retroactively apply for and accept the 2014-15 Operation ABC grant in the amount of \$100,000 from the State of California, Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control for the period July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.
 - b. Execute the 2014-15 Operation ABC Grant Agreement on behalf of the City and submit all necessary documents relative to the grant award, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.

2. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to:

- a. Submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit grant receipts in the Police Department Grants Fund No. 399/70.
- b. Spend up to the grant amount of \$100,000 in accordance with the grant award agreement.

3. AUTHORIZE the Controller to:

- a. Establish a grant receivable in Fund 339 in the amount of \$100,000 and establish an appropriation account, account number to be determined, within the Fund for the receipt and disbursement of grant funds.
- b. Increase appropriations on an as-needed basis as follows:

4. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to prepare Controller's instructions for any necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO); and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The CAO reports that this action will not impact the General Fund. Approval of the above recommendations will allow for the expenditure of \$100,000 from the 2014-15 Operation ABC Grant. The grant will provide partial funding for sworn salaries and overtime funding for sworn personnel. No matching funds are required for this grant. The

remaining sworn salary and fringe benefit costs are already included in the 2014-15 Adopted Budget.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to Council dated July 16, 2014 (attached to the Council file), the CAO states that LAPD seeks retroactive approval to apply for and accept a \$100,000 grant award for the 2014-15 Operation ABC Program from the State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control for the period July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015. Grant funds will be used for LAPD sworn salaries and overtime, training, and equipment. On June 17, 2014, the Board of Police Commissioners approved LAPD's request. The CAO concurs with this action.

According to the CAO, The major objective of Operation ABC is to enforce alcohol sales and use laws and to prevent and/or discourage illegal drugs in ABC licensed businesses, sales of alcoholic beverages to minors, intoxicated patrons, illegal solicitation of alcohol, and other related criminal activities. Operation ABC also provides training for alcohol retailers to educate licensees and their employees in promoting the responsible sale, service and distribution of alcoholic beverages.

At its meeting held August 8, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to apply for and accept the ABC grant award, and to approve the related actions above, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners and the CAO.
