## <u>SUMMARY</u>

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated October 3, 2014 (attached to the Councilfile), LAPD summarizes Supplemental Police Account activity for the period April through June, 2014. During this reporting period, there were 14 Account expenditures in which drugs or assets were seized. These expenditures resulted in 58 arrests and the seizure of \$11,380.00 in United States currency. Also seized were 10,776.44 grams of narcotics with a street value of \$623,275.60. On October 7, 2014, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At its meeting held December 12, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council approve LAPD's report, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners.
