

SUBJECT: Protest Level Tabulation Results for the Renewal of the Wilmington Commercial District Merchant-Based Business Improvement District for the District's 2015 Operating Year (CF 14-0880)

Listed below are the results of the tabulation of valid written protests to the levying of assessments for the Wilmington Commercial District Merchant-Based Business Improvement District ("District") for the District's 2015 operating year that were received before the close of the City Council hearing on Tuesday, May 19, 2015.

1. The valid written protests received from owners of businesses in the District, pursuant to Section 36524 of the California Streets and Highways Code ("Code"), are as follows:

Approximately 140 Notices, Ordinances of Intention and District Annual Reports were mailed by the City Clerk's Office to all identified business owners in the District on April 27, 2015, and no valid written protests were received by the close of the City Council hearing on May 19, 2015. One (1) speaker card was turned in for the final public hearing.
