

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the December 4, 2013 activation of the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and Functional Exercise After Action Report.

Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE the Emergency Operations Board (EOB) report dated June 4, 2014 (attached to the Council file) relative to the December 4, 2013 activation of the EOC and Functional Exercise After Action Report.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the EOB. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

### SUMMARY

In a report to the mayor dated June 4, 2014, the EOB discusses the activation of the EOC and Functional Exercise After Action Report. On December 4, 2013, the City's EOC was activated at a Level 3 Alpha for the annual functional exercise. The focus of the exercise was to test communications processes, information flow, and situational awareness. The exercise used a catastrophic rain storm/flood scenario. Several Department Operations Centers (DOCs) were also activated and the exercise tested communications between the EOC and these DOCs.

The EOB report identifies the departments involved and a chronology of exercise activities. It also provides recommendations of corrective actions specific to the activation of the EOC. The Emergency Management Department will track progress on recommended improvements and, as appropriate, report back to the EOB.

At its special meeting held October 1, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council approve the EOB's report.
