PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the renewal of the Designation of Applicant's Agent Resolution for the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CalOES).

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- APPROVE the accompanying Designation of Applicant's Agent Resolution for Non-State Agencies designating the City Administrative Officer (CAO) as the City's Authorized Agent to execute and deliver certificates, agreements, and other documents required in connection with obtaining Federal and State disaster assistance.
- 2. APPROVE the accompanying Designation of Applicant's Agent Resolution for Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and Pre-disaster Mitigation Program designating the CAO as the City's Authorized Agent to execute and deliver certificates, agreements, and other documents required in connection with obtaining pre-disaster mitigation, hazard mitigation, flood mitigation, and Fire Management Assistance Grant.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The CAO reports that there is no General Fund fiscal impact related to updating the designation of the CAO as the City's Authorized Agent, with respect to applications for State and Federal financial assistance for disasters.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on August 23, 2017, the Public Safety Committee considered a CAO report regarding renewal of City's Authorized Agent for FEMA and CalOES. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended on consent to approve the CAO report. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
