DRAFT ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 85.02 OF THE LOS ANGELES MUNICIPAL CODE TO EXTEND THE SUNSET PROVISION FOR VEHICLE DWELLING ON CITY STREETS TO JANUARY 1, 2019

Honorable Members:

As requested by City Council, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance amends Subsection D of Section 85.02 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to establish a sunset date of January 1, 2019.

The draft ordinance contains an urgency clause, which would allow its provisions to go into effect upon publication. The City's existing law regulating vehicle dwelling sunsets on July 1, 2018. Continuing the existing regulation of vehicle dwelling for another six months avoids the public peace, health and safety concerns that might arise in the absence of any regulation. Those concerns were articulated in the City Council's findings made at the time the existing City law was adopted in November 2016.
