HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to addressing legal issues regarding Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 85.02 - Vehicle Dwelling, and extending the regulation of the use of vehicles for dwelling on public streets; and adding Safe Parking sites to the list of restricted vehicle dwelling areas.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Harris-Dawson - Krekorian):

- 1. REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present an Ordinance to extend the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 85.02 for six months.
- 2. INSTRUCT the Department of City Planning, City Administrative Officer (CAO), Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), and Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority with the assistance of the City Attorney, Los Angeles Police Department, and any Department that is necessary, to report on the feasibility of developing Vehicle Dwelling Parking Programs, and prohibiting vehicle dwelling near the program sites, and restricting vehicle dwelling parking sites from being within 500 feet of schools, pre-schools, daycare facilities, and parks.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

<u>Community Impact Statement</u>: None submitted.

## Summary:
