DRAFT ORDINANCE REINSTATING SECTION 85.02 OF THE LOS ANGELES MUNICIPAL CODE TO REGULATE VEHICLE DWELLING ON CITY STREETS

Honorable Members:

As requested by the City Council, this Office previously transmitted a draft ordinance amending Section 85.02 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to extend the sunset provision for vehicle dwelling on City streets to January 1, 2020. Because the ordinance was not adopted before July 1, 2019, the date it was to sunset, the entire section must be reinstated. Therefore, we have prepared and now transmit the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality, which reinstates Section 85.02 in its entirety along with a sunset date of January 1, 2020.

A copy of the draft ordinance was sent, pursuant to Council Rule 38, to the Department of Recreation and Parks, the Los Angeles Police Department, and the Department of Transportation requesting that all comments, if any, be presented directly to the City Council when this matter is considered.
