# DRAFT ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 85.02 OF THE LOS ANGELES MUNICIPAL CODE PROHIBITING THE USE OF STREETS AND PUBLIC PARKING LOTS FOR HABITIATION

#### Honorable Members:

This Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. This draft ordinance repeals Section 85.02 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC), which makes it unlawful to use a vehicle as living quarters while on any City street or parking lot owned by the City of Los Angeles or under the control of the Los Angeles County Department of Beaches and Harbors.

In 2014, the Ninth Circuit ruled that LAMC Section 85.02 was unconstitutional as currently written. *Desertrain v. City of Los Angeles* 754 F.3d 1147 (9th Cir. 2014). The City Attorney's Office transmitted two alterative draft ordinances to replace LAMC Section 85.02. Due to the passage of time since the Ninth Circuit issued its decision, this Office recommends that the City Council repeal the unconstitutional version of LAMC Section 85.02. Repealing the unconstitutional version in no way precludes the City Council from adopting a replacement to the repealed law at a future date.
