On August 26, 2014, the Greater Echo Park Elysian Neighborhood Council Board of Governors held a Brown Act compliant, noticed regular meeting with a quorum of 14; and with a vote of 13 yeas, 0 nays, and 1 abstention, the GEPENC adopted the motion in support of the City to develop a comprehensive legal framework and effective regulatory system that has the potential to protect health, increase public safety and economic activity, and with the possibility to permit and regulate vending in L.A. City recreations and parks.
