Barbara Yaroslavsky was born and raised in Los Angeles, and always believed that the way to make a difference is by being involved. She has been engaged in a myriad of community projects throughout her career as a community activist. Mainly engaged in opportunities in education and health care issues, she sits on the boards of many nonprofit organizations. Active in the LA Free Clinic for the last 25+ years, Barbara believes that health care is a right and not a privilege. She has both volunteered and sat on that Clinic Board and currently sits on their Friends Board, which raises in excess of 1 million dollars a year. After school programs is another passion of hers, active on the LA's Best Board, a collaborative between the City of Los Angeles, LA Unified School District, and the private sector, this nationally recognized program provides a quality program for over 20,000 students in the Los Angeles City area public schools. She sits on the Undergraduate Student Scholarship Committee at UC San Diego and is a strong proponent in education for all regardless of financial circumstances. Barbara is active on several boards at the Jewish Federation Council of Greater Los Angeles, from the Bureau of Jewish Education to the Jewish Community Relations Board (JCRC), previously having chaired for a two year term the Jewish Public Affairs Committee (JPAC), a statewide lobbying organization made up of many statewide constituency organizations and federations.

She participates on the executive committee of the Jewish Labor Committee and finds time to participate in several multicultural dialogue groups. She heads up a special projects group for the Zimmer Children's Museum and engaged in maintaining and securing funding for their youTHink project which is in many public school classrooms statewide, as well as participating in the Jewish community's response to literacy through the Koreh L.A. task force which currently has in excess of 1,000 volunteers that are reading with children in our elementary schools. She is a member of the Executive Service Corps., placing former executives into the non-profit arena to assist in coaching and consulting activities to strengthen their boards and organizations. Barbara currently sits on the Medical Board of California, participating actively a public member of the Division of Medical Quality.

Barbara is a life member of Hadassah and a former president of her chapter as well as holding several executive board positions. She is also a former PTA president as well as having served in a variety of positions in the schools that her children attended.

Barbara is the proud parent of two special kids. She is married to Zev for the last 34+ years and is equally proud of his community endeavors on behalf of a multitude of citizens.
