<u>Summary</u>

At a public hearing on February 3, 2016, the Energy and Environment Committee considered a LADWP communication relative to an overview of the LADWP standard electric rate structure, incremental electric rate structure, and water rate structure. Staff from the LADWP, Office of the City Attorney, and the Rate Payer Advocate presented to the Committee background information as well as detailed overviews for general, power, and water ratemaking. Other topics discussed included the composition of each rate structure, both residential and commercial, and the purpose of each surcharge and pass-through adjustment associated with each rate structure.

After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council receive and file the LADWP communication dated January 29, 2016, submitted in response to Motion (Fuentes - Huizar). This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
