Summary:

On August 27, 2014, the Transportation Committee considered an August 21, 2014 LADOT report relative to the Bicycle Plan Implementation Annual Report for FY 2013-14. According to the LADOT, the annual report on implementation of the 2010 Bicycle Plan provides a summary of the implementation milestones made by the LADOT and the Los Angeles Department of City Planning between July 1, 2013 and June 30, 2014. This report highlights progress installing planned bicycle facilities, current planning outreach efforts, ongoing bicycle program implementation, and grant funding requests to support future projects of the LADOT Bicycle Program. Parallel City efforts, such as the Mobility Plan 2035, the LADOT Strategic Plan, and the Mayor's Great Streets Initiative will shape the work program for the coming years. The rapidly-evolving design best practices coupled with a more holistic policy framework will influence the future goals of the program.

Representatives from the LADOT provided an overview of the 2010 Bicycle Plan implementation and answered questions from the Committee members. A full summary is provided in the LADOT report. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Transportation Committee moved to receive and file the LADOT report. Subsequently, on August 16, 2016, the Planning and Land Use Management Committee also considered the LADOT report and after having provided an opportunity for public comment, moved to concur with the Transportation Committee. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
